

Amendment to Sailing Instruction 10.1

Change the color of the Check-in Buoy in the second sentence from “orange” to “red sponsor buoy.”

So that SI 10.1 shall now read as:

“10.1 Boats in the Racing Divisions, prior to entering the starting area, shall power to the east end of Navy Pier, then proceed approximately 1200 feet due east to the Race Committee Check-In Boat. Each boat shall then leave the Race Committee Check-In-Boat to port while passing between the Race Committee Check In-Boat and a red sponsor buoy while displaying its CMSR compliant reflective sailboard on its port side and be acknowledged before proceeding through the Chicago Harbor Lighthouse Gap to the starting area. The Race Committee Check-In Boat will display code flag “L” and be on station from 0930 CDT to 1230 CDT. Check-In by radio is not permitted.”

Amendment to Sailing Instruction 11.2

ADD the following sentence at the end of SI 11.2:

“... However, a boat in its starting sequence (or, having just started), and is attempting to return to the pre-race side of the starting-line, may sail around either end of the line.”
